Letter from Coach Danny Kaspar

Dear Lumberjack Basketball fans, spring is here and the 2004-05 basketball season is in the record books. It's been a disappointing season for us! Our record was 12-15 and we did not make the Southland Conference tournament. It was our first non-post season tournament appearance since the 2000-01 season. Needless to say, we must get back to where we were.

Recruiting will occupy most of our time in April. We have already signed two high school players during the early signing period and are very happy to have them on board. Jerel Hastings is a 6'5" wing player from Dallas South Oak Cliff High School. His team won the 4A state championship this year and Jerel played a huge role on the team. Josh Alexander is a 6'4" shooting guard out of Shreveport Byrd High School. He is a very good shooter/athlete.

Our goal is to sign five more recruits during the April signing period. The main focus is on guards and big men. With the loss of Taylor Moore, Hank Rivers, and Rodrigo Segantim, size and inside play is of great importance in our recruiting efforts. We also hope to sign three guards during this time. Tim Simon, Leonard Brown, and Jerry Cheves will need to be replaced. Most of our spring recruiting will center on the need to sign junior college transfers.

Marcus Clark was named second team all-conference by the coaches and Patrick Hannaway has been nominated for the Southland Conference All-Academic team. We are very happy and proud for these two young men.

Our last newsletter will go out in early May and should include a list of spring signings. In the meantime, my staff and I will be very busy with both our on-campus and off-campus recruiting. I hope you and your family have a great April.

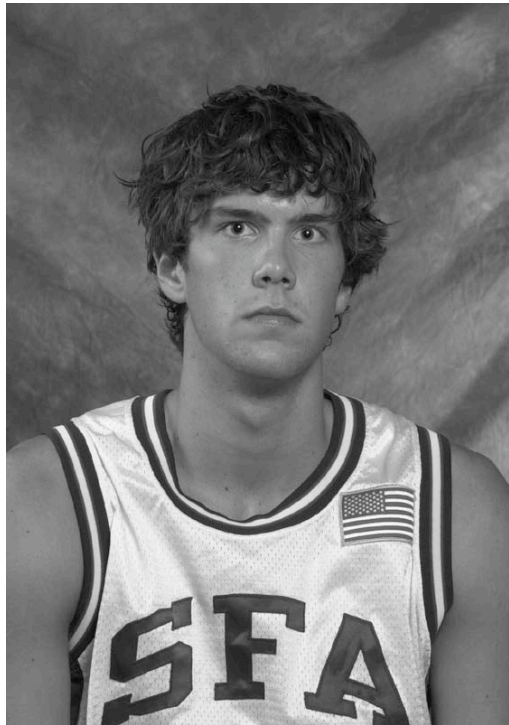

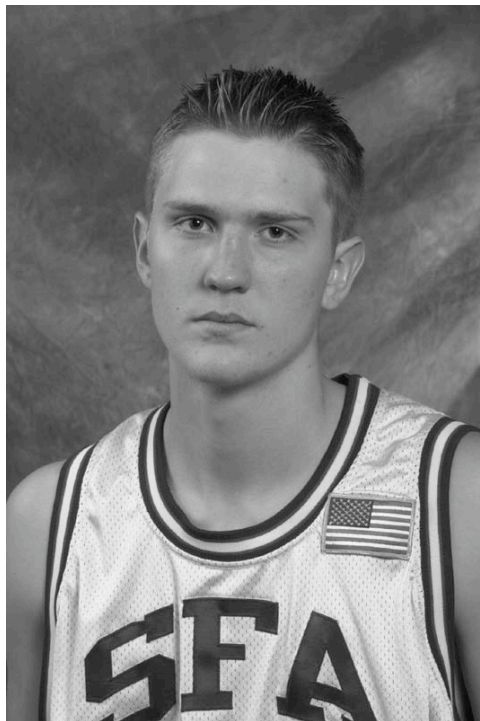
